1 Introduction

In the new version of Artikelbeheer.nl, the submity of data has been greatly simplified. This manual describes how data can be submitted to this updated version of Artikelbeheer.nl.

2 Submitting data in Artikelbeheer.nl

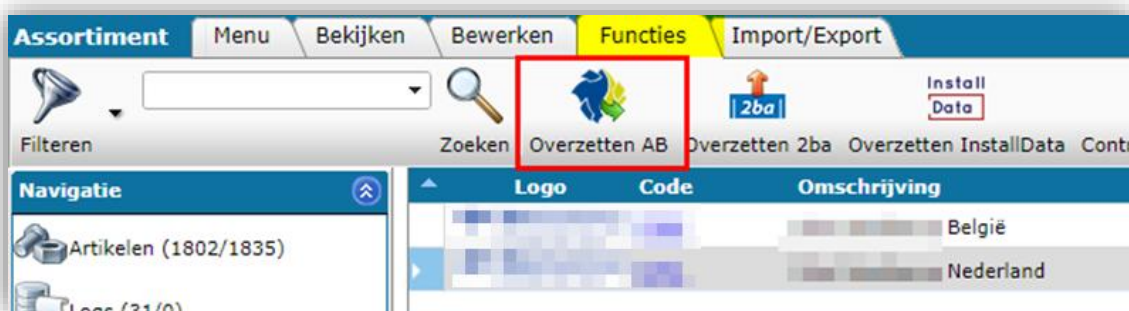
The renewed Artikelbeheer.nl is available (from January 2023) for the submitting of data via:

- Compano (PIM) environment
- FTPS

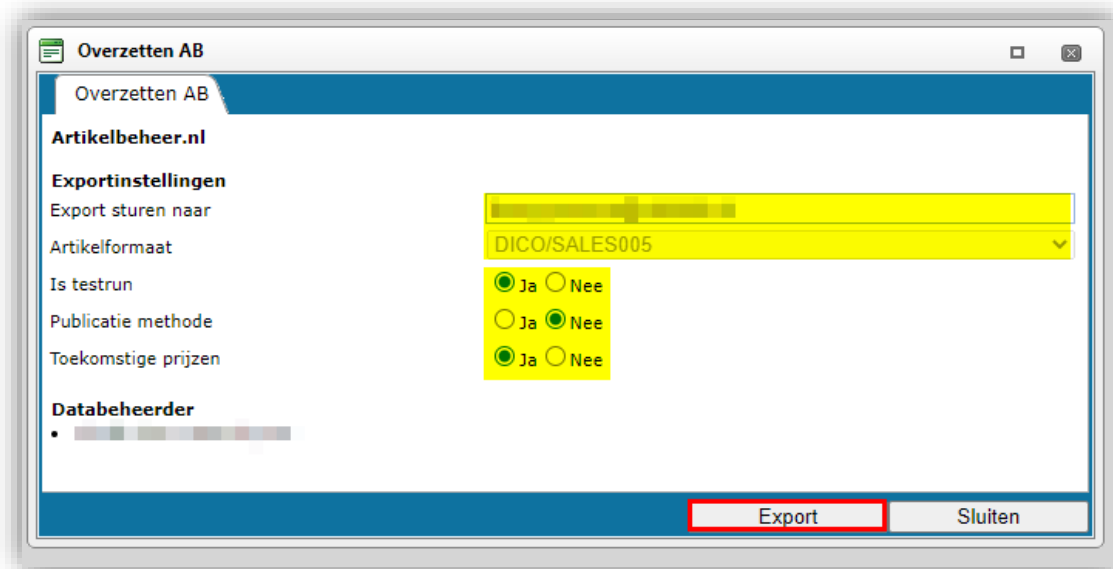
2.1 Via Compano [PIM] environment

Submitting via a PIM environment¹ will continue to work in more or less the same way:

1. Go to the Menu, to *Artikelen > Assortiment*.
2. Select the assortment you want to submit and under Functions click on *Overzetten AB*.



3. In the pop-up window:



- a. Export sturen naar: The export report will be sent to this e-mail address.

- b. Artikelformaat: DICO/SALES005 (default).
 - c. Is testrun:
 - i. Ja: Set this option to *Ja* if you want to test the transfer to AB first; you will receive an export report with errors and warnings, but no data will be transferred yet.
 - ii. Nee: Set this option to *Nee* if you want to transfer the data to AB immediately if there are no errors.
 - d. Publicatie methode: The option appears when you set *Is testrun* to *Ja*.
 - i. Ja: If *there are no errors*, publish the data directly on AB.
 - ii. Nee: Only do a test run and send an export report.
 - e. Toekomstige prijzen: Set this option to *Ja* if you also want to export future prices.
4. Click *Export*.

2.2 Via FTPS

Data for Artikelbeheer.nl can also be provided via the FTPS protocol. For this you will need a FTPS client, such as the freely available client from [FileZilla](#).

Note: FTPS is a different protocol than SFTP, so make sure you use *FTPS* when setting up .

Before submitting data via FTPS, please read the following instructions:

2.2.1 FTPS account

To submit via FTPS, you will need a Compano FTPS user account:

You can request a FTPS account via info@artikelbeheer.nl . Note: Your GLN will be your username.

2.2.2 FTPS security and firewall settings

The FTPS protocol uses *encrypted data transfer*:

- Data upload is only allowed from certain IP addresses of your organization.
- Your organization's *firewall* must have certain ports open:
 - Outgoing: Port 21
 - Incoming: Ports 64441 to 64447

Inform your system administrator or IT department about the correct settings of IP address(es) and ports in the firewall.

2.2.3 Submit via FTPS

Submitting data for Artikelbeheer.nl can only be done in certain file formats:

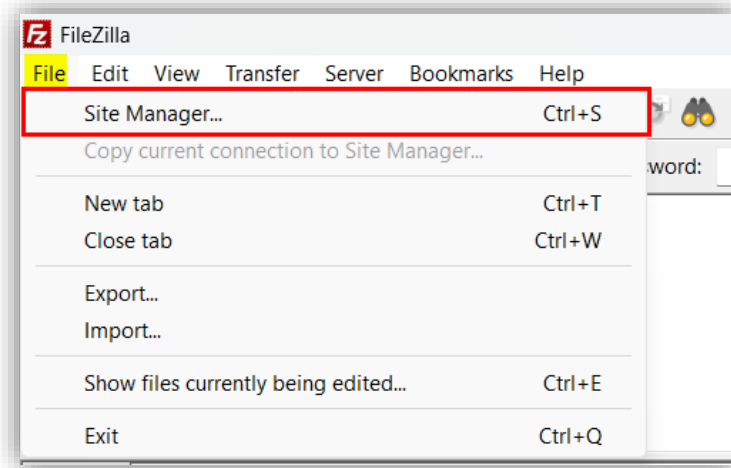
The data must be offered in one of the following industry formats: PAB, INSBOU, DICO/SALES or BMEcat.

To provide data:

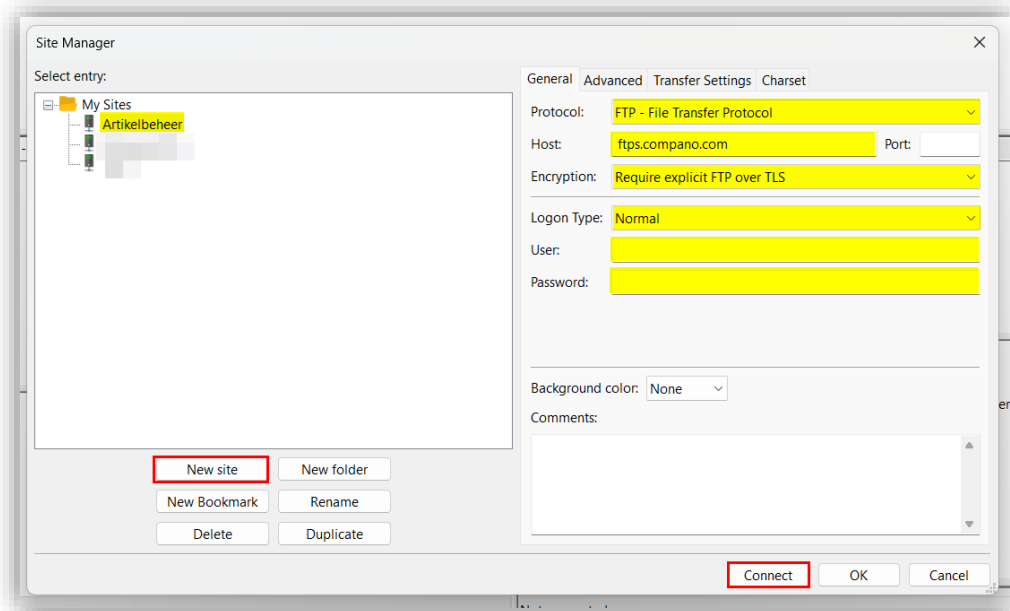
1. Launch the FTPS client, such as *FileZilla*, and connect to the Compano FTPS server. To do so, enter the correct details at *Host*, *Username*, and *Password*. Then click on *Quick Connect* button.

Host address: ftps.compano.com
 Encryption: **Explicit FTP over TLS**

- a. In the FileZilla menu, go to the *File > Site Manager*:



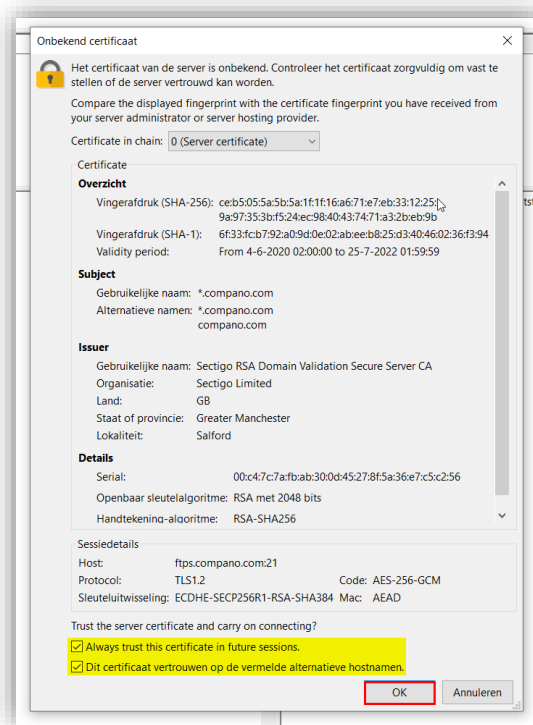
- b. In the pop-up window, click on *New site* and on the *General tab*, enter the following:



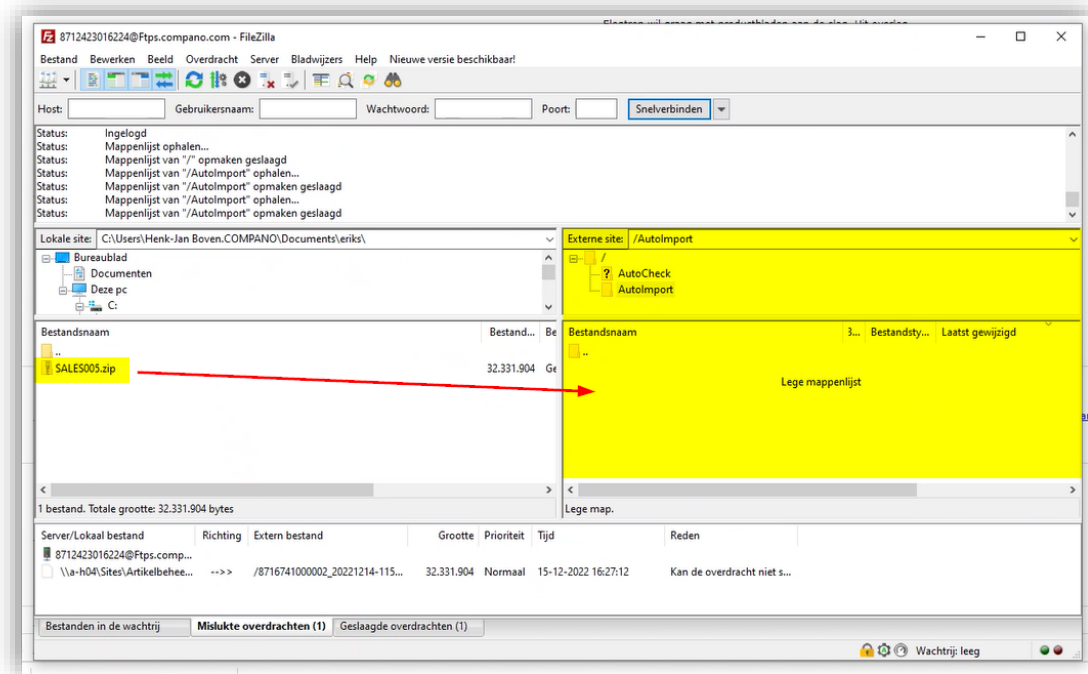
- i. Protocol: Select the regular **FTP - File Transfer Protocol**
- ii. Host: **ftps.compano.com**
- iii. Encryption: Select **Require Explicit FTP over TLS**
- iv. Login Type: Select **Normal**
- v. User: Type your FTPS username
- vi. Password: Type your FTPS password

c. Then click *Connect* to establish the connection.

Note: When you *first* connect to a new, secure FTPS site, you must trust the *security certificate*. Make sure you tick the boxes correctly and then click *OK*:



3. On the FTPS server, you will now see two folders: *AutoCheck* and *AutoImport*.



4. Drag and drop your data file into the *AutoCheck* or *AutoImport* folder.

Note: AutoCheck will perform a test run where you have the option to check any changes in your Artikelbeheer.nl data. AutoImport will perform a real import and change of your data.

- a. AutoCheck: Data file is compared with the current dataset on Artikelbeheer.nl; a report is drawn up and sent to your email address.

Note: Once the data is approved, the file must *always* be manually uploaded to the *AutoImport* folder for actual processing, *unless the following is specified* in the **parameters.xml** of the data file:

<PublishMethod>AutoAcceptStagingData</PublishMethod>.

This is only possible for the data file types PAB, DICO/INSBOU and DICO/SALES.

- b. AutoImport: Data file is read and processed. A report is sent to the e-mail address indicated in the **parameters.xml** of the database.
5. Data processing via FTPS is automated.

Important: Data read via the *AutoImport* folder is processed *after 00:00* and is then *immediately live* on Artikelbeheer.nl 2.0; there is no staging environment anymore.

PARAMETERS.XML FOR BMECAT

A self-made *parameters.xml* can be added to a *BMEcat zip file*. An example of this XML file is available from the Compano Help page.

Note: A few parameters still need to be adjusted manually:

- **FILE TYPE** (optional): Specify the type of data file, for example, **BMEcat**, or **INSBOU004**.
- **CSUTOMER NAME** (optional): Type the customer name here.
- **E-MAIL ADRESSESS FOR REPORT**: Type the email address(es), semicolon separated, for everyone who needs to receive the report of the upload.
- **SUPPLIER** (optional): Type the name of the supplier here.

2.3 File stream (OAuth)

As an alternative to FTPS, data files can also be uploaded to Artikelbeheer.nl by using a *file stream* in combination with the *OAuth authorization protocol*.

Note: The file stream option must be built into your application.

Compano provides:

- An OAuth authentication token
- A username and password²
- Upload URL: <https://centraal.artikelbeheer.nl/api/SubmitUpload/UploadFile>
- The upload URL must be used in conjunction with the **stream** function

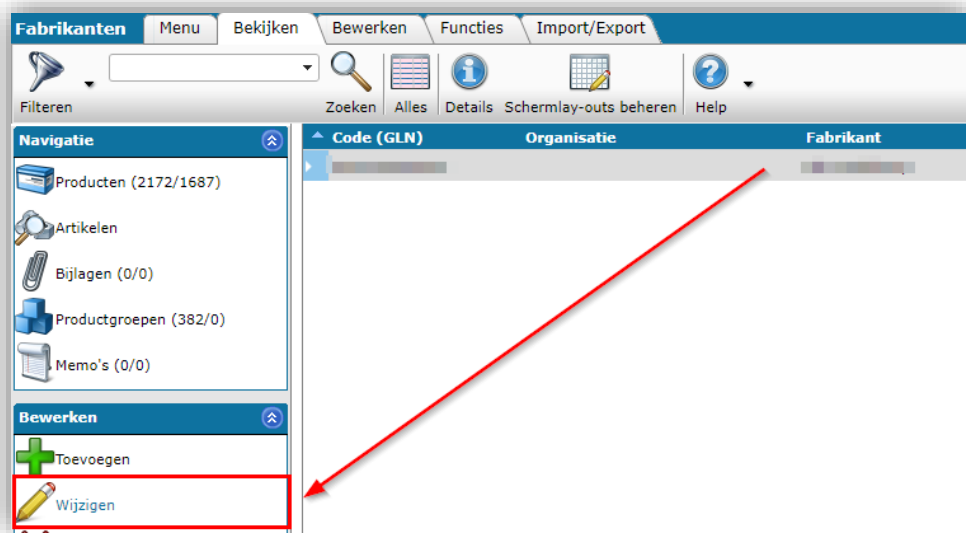
This uploads the file into the *AutoImport* folder.

Important: Only industry-standard data files, such as DICO/SALES005 can be processed by Artikelbeheer.nl.

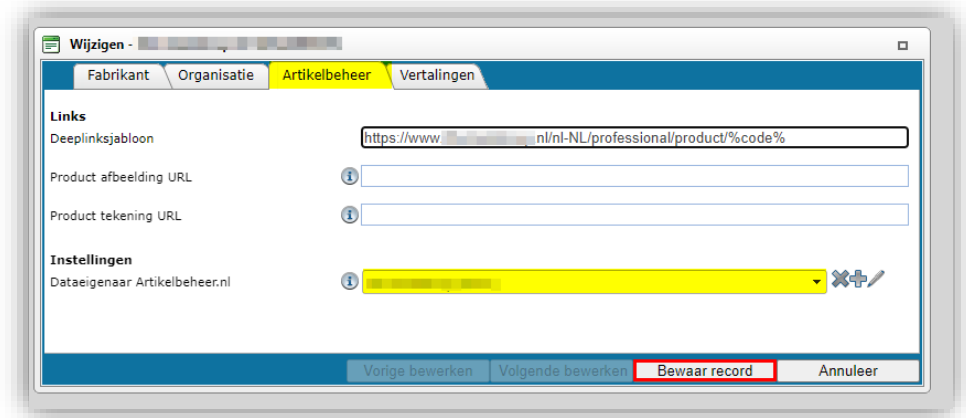
2.4 Data ownership AB

If you, as a manufacturer, submit data to Artikelbeheer.nl yourself, you can claim data ownership. This prevents third parties with access to Artikelbeheer.nl from making changes to your product data:

1. Through the Menu, go to *Producten > Fabrikanten*.
2. Select the Manufacturer and, under *Bewerken*, click *Wijzigen*.



3. In the pop-up window, go to the *Artikelbeheertab*:

- a. Dataeigenaar Artikelbeheer.nl: Choose yourself as the Data Owner from the drop-down menu.
4. Click on *Bewaar record*.
